

Donor Scholarship Application FAQs

Below are answers to commonly asked questions about applying for donor scholarships at the University of Maryland School of Nursing (UMSON).

1. What are the award amounts for donor scholarships?

Award amounts vary depending on the available annual funding for each individual scholarship.

2. If I missed the deadline, can I still apply?

No, applications will not be accepted after the deadline.

3. Can I apply for and receive more than one donor scholarship?

We aim to distribute scholarship funding to as many eligible students as possible each year. Therefore, students are typically awarded only one donor scholarship.

4. How do I apply for donor scholarships?

To apply, click the **Apply Now** link available during the application period.

5. I was awarded a donor scholarship last year. Do I need to submit an application to renew my scholarship?

Yes, donor scholarship awards are not automatically renewed. You must reapply each year to be considered.

6. How will I be notified if I receive a donor scholarship?

Students who are selected for a donor scholarship will be notified via email.

7. If awarded, how will I receive the funds?

The scholarship amount will be posted to your student account. It will be applied to tuition, fees, and other education-related expenses.

8. Why didn't I receive a scholarship?

Due to the limited number of scholarships available and the large number of applicants, we are unable to award scholarships to all deserving students.

9. Can I view the list of available donor scholarships before starting my application?

Yes, the list of available scholarships is included on the donor scholarship page. It is strongly recommended that you review this information before applying to ensure you meet the eligibility requirements.

10. Can I update my application after submitting it?

No, once an application is submitted, it cannot be edited. Please carefully review your application before submission.
